

SSPT Travel Grants for Post-Graduates in Biomedical Sciences

The SSPT provides travel grants to post-graduates in Biomedical Sciences in training supporting travel to international scientific conferences. The travel grants are awarded twice a year: May 15 and October 15.

Pre-requisites

- Grants are awarded to members of the SSEP, SST, SSCPT or SSPM.
- The minimum membership must be at least one year at the time of application.
- Only PhDs and MDs in advanced training are eligible for SSPT PhD/MD travel grants; copy of diploma must be provided.
- Active participation at the conference is a prerequisite, i.e. the applicant presents a poster or has been invited for an oral presentation.
- The application must include the application form, an abstract of the presentation, a short CV, proof of membership payment, and the draft budget for travel expenses.
- Applications have to be submitted by individuals (no institutional applications)
- Travel (2nd class), registration and accommodation are funded.
- Annual submission deadlines (May 15 and October 15) should be respected.
- Applications have to be submitted no later than 2 months before the start of the conference.
- Maximum of two travel grants per lifetime.
- The supported work (active participation) is expected to be presented at the Annual Meeting of the SSPT.

Amount of support

- The maximum funding per application is limited to 1000,- CHF.

Decision process

- The decision on the application will be taken by the council of the SSPT in due time. The applicant and the president of the society (SSEP, SST, SSCPT or SSPM) will be directly informed about the outcome.
